Rose Bowl Half-Marathon & 5K

This notice is to inform you that the Rose Bowl Half-Marathon will be held, tomorrow, Saturday, December 13, 2008. Residents and visitors should be advised to expect delays when traveling in the Arroyo Seco area. PARKING INFORMATION FOR RESIDENTS

In preparation for the event, the route will be posted with no parking restrictions from 7am–12:30pm. In addition, the issuance of overnight parking citations (2am–6am) will be suspended the morning of December 13. During this time, overnight parking permits will NOT be required to park on City streets within a ¼ mile radius of the route. However, all other parking restrictions and prohibitions apply including the temporary tow away zones associated with the marathon route.

Listed below are the streets that will be affected by the Rose Bowl Half-Marathon. Please try to schedule any vehicular traffic around the times listed. Thank you very much for your patience and cooperation!

ROAD CLOSURES: Parking restrictions 7am-12:30pm

Arroyo Blvd. from Seco to Madeline (7:40am-8:50am)

Madeline Drive from Arroyo to Orange Grove (7:45am-9:10am)

Orange Grove Blvd. from Madeline to Rosemont Ave (8:00am-9:40am):
The Southbound lanes of Orange Grove will be closed, but two-way travel

will be maintained in the Northbound lanes. If you are a resident in between Arroyo and Orange Grove, please proceed to Green, California, or Bellefontaine Street to access Orange Grove.

Rosemont Avenue from Orange Grove to Seco (8:10am-9:40am)

Rosemont Avenue from Seco to Washington (7:30am-10:30am)

Linda Vista Ave. from Highland Drive to Yocum (8:40am-11:45am):
Linda Vista will be open to two-way travel throughout the event.

Yocum Street from Linda Vista to Parkview (8:40am-Noon)***

Parkview Avenue from Yocum to West Drive (8:40am-Noon)

West Drive from Parkview to Seco (8:00am-12:30pm)

Seco Street from West Drive to Rosemont (7:30am-12:30pm)

FREEWAY OFF-RAMP CLOSURES:

On race day, the Orange Grove & Holly Street off-ramps on the 134 Freeway will be closed from 6am-10am.

***** Indicates roads with soft closures. Vehicles will be permitted to travel away from closed roads when there is a gap between runners.**
