Balloon Exercise to Continue at Art Center

A big balloon at Art Center College of Design's Lida Street campus was in place in early January but bad weather hampered residents' ability to see it.

Residents of Pasadena who look to the west on this Friday, Saturday and Sunday, January 18, 19 and 20, will have additional opportunities to see the balloon, which will be at the same height and location as a building Art Center College of Design proposes in its master development plan for the Lida Street Campus.

The balloon will be as tall as a building that Art Center College of Design proposes in its master development plan.

The balloon modeling exercise at the Lida Street campus will help complete the visual analysis for the college's environmental impact report. The balloon will show the highest point of the atrium structure that is the central design feature of the proposed Design Research Center Building. The proposed site location is the lawn behind the existing Ellwood Building and the edge of the hillside.

We hope the balloon will be visible to residents in the Lida Street area adjacent to the campus and hopefully across the Arroyo and from other high points in the City.

We hope you will take a little time to observe the placement of the balloon and let us know your impression. If you are looking for the campus from

Arroyo Blvd., please note you should be able to see the balloon(s) up the hill from the Brookside Clubhouse.
