**What follows is a partial summary of what your generosity has enabled the Linda Vista-Annandale Association (LVAA) to accomplish recently for the benefit of our neighborhood.**

LVAA created TWO public City of Pasadena Parks in our area: The Linda Vista Neighborhood Park AND the new Annandale Canyon Nature Preserve.

LVAA advocated for and obtained the recent clean-up of the closed Linda Vista school site as we continue to work for ongoing site maintenance. We envision transforming the whole property into a public Pasadena Park and Community Center.

LVAA works continuously with Rose Bowl staff and the City to manage Rose Bowl events, including advocacy for effective Neighborhood Protection from, for example, traffic and parking impacts. We also advocate for the preservation of the Arroyo Seco, and we are currently focused on the Rose Bowl "Family Golf" proposed project.

LVAA continues to advocate for an effective Wildfire/Disaster Evacuation Plan for the neighborhood in light of severe restrictions such as steep hills and narrow, winding roads and traffic, crowds and other Rose Bowl event impacts.

LVAA is working to preserve our neighborhood's historic streetlights, preserving so far, to the extent feasible, the historic street lighting on Linda Vista Ave. We will continue our efforts to preserve historic street lighting throughout the neighborhood.

LVAA worked to limit, control and mitigate short-term rentals to keep the Linda Vista-Annandale neighborhood a family neighborhood.

LVAA continues to monitor public safety issues and advocate for expanded Police and Fire attention to our neighborhood area.
